The Space School's aim is to provide a stimulating and rewarding educational experience for Year 10 students in South Australia with a focus for them to pursue a career in science, engineering, aviation and astronomy. With the recent establishment of the Australian Space Agency in Adelaide, opportunities in the space sector are within easy reach.

The application process involves a written personal statement prepared by the student, a referee statement from your child's school, and this consent form. We will be contacting your child's school to obtain the school referee statement and to verify the information provided in this consent form. Your child's email address will be used only for informative purposes related to the application and (if relevant) registration. It will not be used for any other purpose without parent/guardian consent.

Space school staff and supervision

The South Australian Space School is run by volunteers who are passionate and dedicated about Space Education. We are senior school Science teachers, or have been and since retired, or are scientists and engineers of the Defence Science and Technology Group with appropriate first aid training. All staff possess valid Working With Children Checks.

There are a minimum of two staff present at all times; this includes male and female staff members at overnight accommodation. The style of supervision at any one time will vary depending on the nature of the activity but will always be one of:

- Direct: Participating staff are at the activity location, supervising and/or instructing each child
- General: Staff oversee the total activity, which may be occurring in smaller groups
- Indirect: Staff oversee the activity at a distance which ensures safety but minimises interruption, for example oversight of guest instructors supervising an activity
